WHO CAN USE ANI-MEALS ON WHEELS?

Participants may be enrolled in the program based on financial need, mobility challenges, or health circumstances. Participants may apply directly to the HSBC or may be referred by Berks County Office of Aging, a family member, doctor, hospital discharge planners, visiting nurse associations, and social service agencies.

HOW CAN YOU HELP?

The HSBC needs donations of pet food, cat litter and other supplies, volunteers for delivery and preparation, and financial support to make this program and others possible.
